VCNLS Finish is a special finish that requires daily care to keep it good condition. We would like you to aware of some tips.

- *Remove stains promptly because it is more difficult to remove as the time passes.
- *Do not use cleaners such as chemical wipes or melamine sponge.
- *Use soft cloth. However, even with soft cloth, it will damage the finish if you wipe too strongly.
- *Do not use cleaning agents which contain organic solvent because it may damage the finish.

Daily stains/dust

- 1) When you notice stains, wipe it away with a soft dry cloth.
- 2) If stain remains, wipe stain gently with a wet soft cloth that has been wrung out. Dry with a soft cloth to remove all moisture.

Coffee or Tea

- 1) When you notice stains, wipe away with a soft dry cloth.
- **2)** Wet a soft cloth and wring out. Dab stains with cloth to let it percolate out. Then wipe any moisture with a soft dry cloth. If stain remains, move to step 3.
- **3)** Prepare neutral kitchen detergent* diluted by 100 times. Wet a soft cloth with the solution and wring out. Then wipe the stain away. Repeat step 2. If stain remains, move to step 4.

Note) Please pay attention not to leave neutral detergent on the surface.

- * Do not use any agents that contain abrasive
- **4)** Prepare ethanol diluted by 10 times. Lightly wet soft cloth with the solution and dab lightly on the stain to remove. Repeat step 2.

Note) Pay attention to the surface (If glossiness changes or not, how stains perform) during cleaning.

5) If necessary, increase concentration rate of ethanol little by little and follow the step 4 instruction, then repeat step 2.
